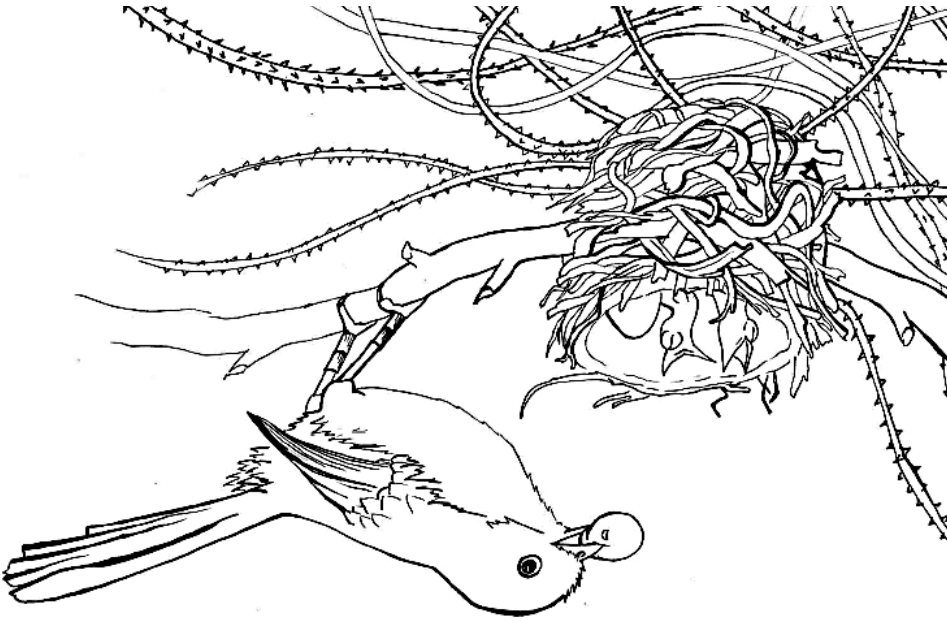

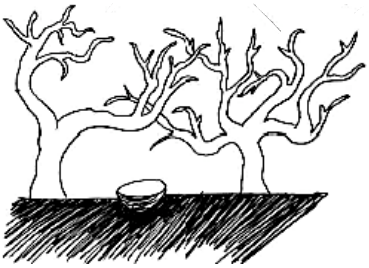

 year long. They have small blue eggs.



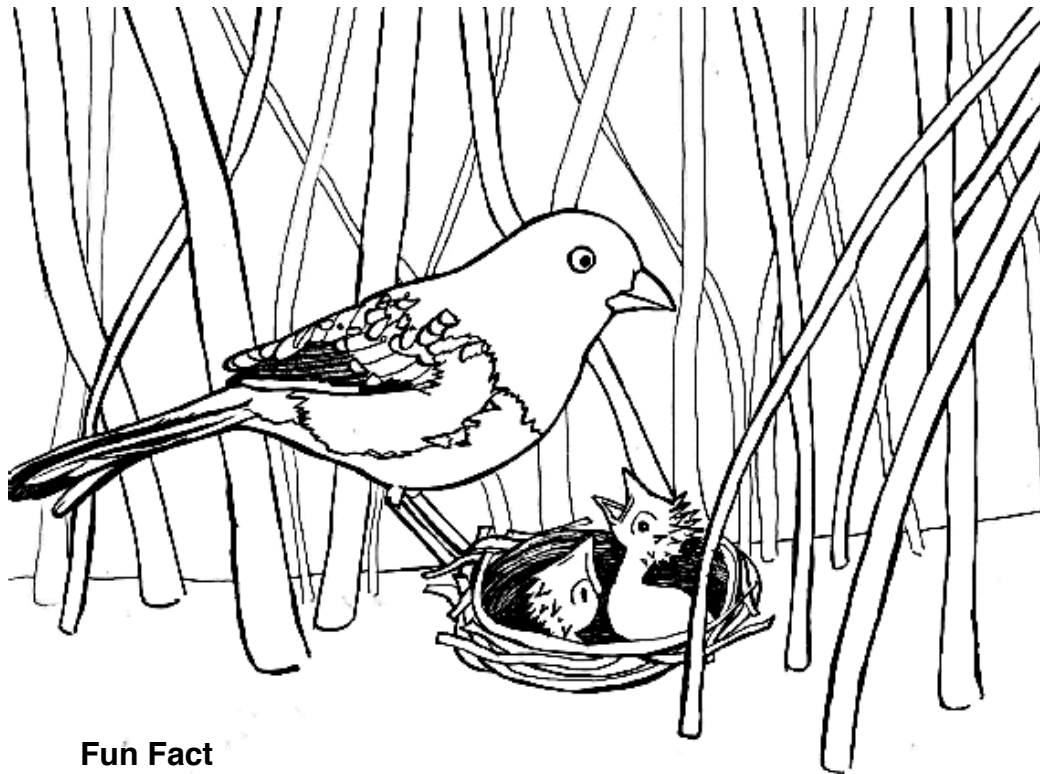
On the ground

 The male sings nearby.



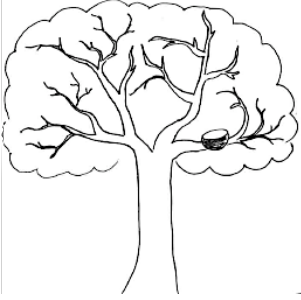

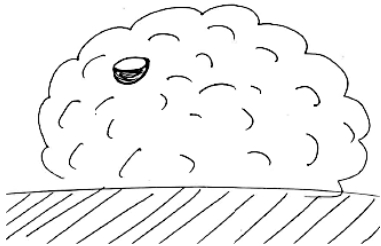
